Dear valuable customers,

Seal Supply is aware of the global ongoing activities related to the chemical substances defined as PFAS¹ and is paying attention to the EU commission and the US EPA chemical strategy actions to address the PFAS as critical chemicals.

On the 7th February 2023, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), published the EU PFAS restriction proposal, submitted by five competent authorities of Germany, Denmark, the Netherlands, Norway, and Sweden, focused on reducing or eliminating the presence of PFAS in the environment. The proposal foresees to ban the manufacture, use and placing on the market (including import into the EU) of all per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS)¹, including fluoropolymers such as FKM, FFKM and PTFE.

The expected date of entry into force has been postponed, and current indications suggest implementation is unlikely before 2027. The first proposed restriction includes a ban and time limited derogations for some uses specific.

Our clear priority is to find for our customers the best alternatives and our R&D is now devoted to identifying and developing new solutions to overcome the PFAS restrictions when eventually confirmed. NFS (non fluorosurfactant) based fluoropolymers have been made available by different polymers' producers and we are in close contact with our suppliers to make them available as sustainable replacements to offer you the newest technology for fluoropolymers.

In the meantime, we will continue to offer you our standard products delivered in accordance with the regulations in force.
